## Every year our group helps hundreds of cats and kittens to a better life.

We do not have a central cattery. Homeless cats are fostered in the homes of our volunteers or in outdoor cat reception units. These units are purpose built, spacious and comfortable for the cats. They have an electrical supply and heating for cold nights.

However spacious the units, we cannot mix cats from different backgrounds. Only cats coming from the same home can be accommodated together. This is why we cannot always take in cats at a moment's notice. We generally have a waiting list of cats to come in to our units, and try to work through the list in a fair way. Having said that, we do normally manage to take in any cat that is in urgent need of attention - either medical or just TLC.

Our fosterers are spread through our area; Glastonbury, Street, Wells, Shepton Mallet, Oakhill, and all surrounding areas.

As well as rehoming cats we are heavily involved in the trapping and neutering of feral cats - an arduous and time-consuming task but one that is

very necessary. We aim to ensure that feral cats are healthy and restrict the size of feral colonies to manageable proportions.

We also run Neutering Campaigns designed to encourage cat owners to have their cats neutered. The amount we ask owners to pay is generally around £15 per cat including free microchipping. When we aren't actively running a campaign, we still offer vouchers for £25 for males and £40 for females. Both offers are available to people on low income support or benefit.

Before cats are rehomed, all prospective homes are checked by



one of our team of home checkers.

As well as looking after the cats and searching out new homes for them, most of our fosterers are involved in fundraising. We have a Christmas Fair each year in Wells Town Hall. We also hold stalls at local events during the summer months, and opened a Charity Shop in Street on November 30th 2016.

We currently have around 200 members who each receive a 4 monthly newsletter - Mews.

All of our helpers are VOLUNTEERS. We do it because we love cats and want to give them a better life. Most of our helpers have to juggle a full time job and/or family commitments with the cat welfare tasks. At times the work is hard, demanding and thankless. At other times it's the most rewarding work in the world. We rely heavily on our members to back us up with fundraising or



giving homes to our cats. We couldn't do it without them.

If YOU love cats and want to help the homeless and needy cats in YOUR area; please join our group. Yearly membership is only £6. Please complete the form at the end of this newsletter and send it to Cats Protection at the address given.

We also run a sponsorship scheme where cat lovers can pay a regular sum towards the upkeep of one of our long stay cats. These are, for instance, the unfortunate cats who have suffered at the hands of humans and need plenty of tender loving care before they are rehomed, or the old or ugly ones that everyone overlooks - especially when there are kittens to be had.

The following list offers suggestions on just *some* of the ways you could help. We know everyone is busy these days, but just a few hours of your time even a couple of times a year would make a big difference to us.

#### **FUNDRAISING**
