

NEW TREASURER URGENTLY REQUIRED

Glastonbury and Wells Cats Protection URGENTLY need a new treasurer.

Cats Protection is a National Cat Rescue and Welfare Charity, taking in lost and unwanted cats, and finding new homes for them. We also encourage [neutering](#) and advise on general cat welfare problems.

The Glastonbury & Wells Branch of Cats Protection, covers a largely rural part of Somerset including Shepton Mallet, Wells, Glastonbury, Street, Cheddar, Castle Cary and surrounding area. All of our cats are kept at the homes of volunteer fosterers because we have no central shelter.

During 2016 our branch homed a total of 110 cats and kittens. Of these 14 were homed direct from their owners. Our figures would be much higher if we didn't run our regular [neutering campaigns](#) which are continuing with a campaign in February to March & September to November.

During the year we helped members of the public with the cost of neutering 248 of their own cats, in addition to helping with the cost of 32 ferals.

Our current treasurer needs to step down from the post due to other commitments but will be on hand to give help and training to her replacement.

It is a volunteer post but expenses will of course be paid.

The post involves checking and paying bills and expenses and also banking of donations and adoption fees.

All the transactions on our monthly bank statement have to be input into the charity's Cashlog system and reconciled to the closing balance on the bank statement on a monthly basis.

We estimate that the work generally takes up to 12 hours per month but it must be appreciated that this isn't split evenly through the month. This is a very general overview but it will be familiar to anyone experienced in the accountancy field.

Much more detail can be supplied to interested parties. Training on the use of our Cashlog reporting system can be arranged and our head office accounts dept are on hand to give advice and support, as are the rest of the local committee of volunteers. We all help each other.

The branch has no one able to take up this commitment. We are all too involved in other aspects of cat welfare work, fundraising etc so PLEASE TRY AND HELP IF YOU CAN.
